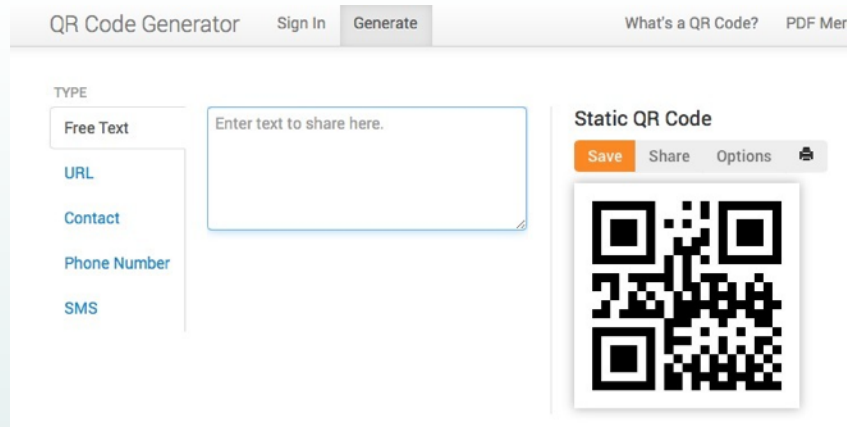


AOE's Quick Guide for Using QR Codes in the Art Room

For this guide, we're using the website [QR Code Generator](#), seen below.



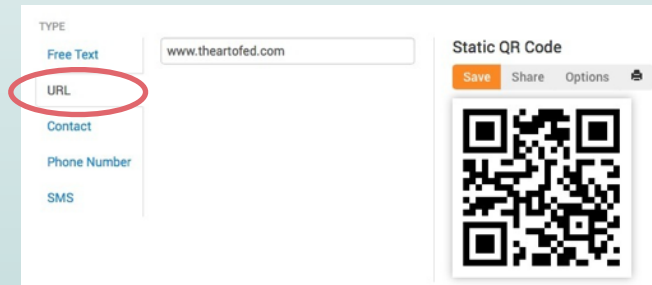
Step 1: Decide what type of content you want your QR Code to link to.

Create a QR code that links to a website or a QR code that links to plain text. Linking to a website could be useful for promoting your blog or sharing videos of students explaining their work. Linking to plain text could be useful for creating scavenger hunts or assigning drawing prompts.

Step 2: Create your QR Code.

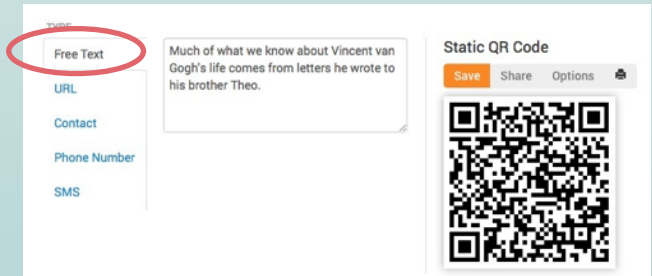
For a Website

1. Go to QR Code Generator
2. Choose "URL"
3. Enter your web address in the box.
4. Your QR Code will be generated on the right.



For Plain Text

1. Go to QR Code Generator
2. Choose "Free Text"
3. Enter your text in the box.
4. Your QR Code will be generated on the right.



Step 3: Save your QR Code.*

To Print

1. Click "Save"
2. Re-name your QR code if you'd like to save it to your computer.
3. Print your QR code for immediate use.

To Use on the Web

1. Click "Share"
2. Copy and paste the html code to embed the QR Code into your website.

* Note: It's a good idea to test your Code with a QR Reader before saving!
