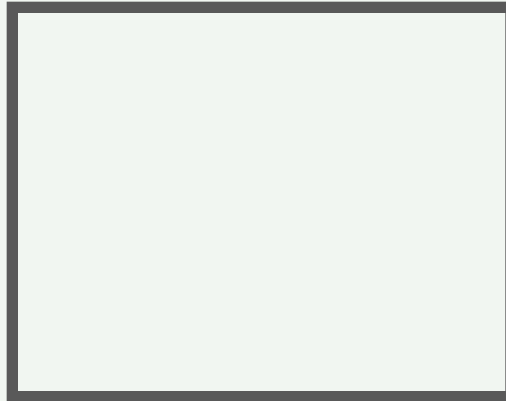


Parents Corner

Tips for Your Visit with Children:

- ◆ Preview Artwork with your children and focus on their favorites.
- ◆ Locate Restrooms when you arrive, check coats, and information.
- ◆ You don't have to whisper at the Frist. Encourage kids to talk about the art.
- ◆ Make a game of looking at art:
 - ◆ How many squares do you see?
 - ◆ Make up stories about the people in the art.
- ◆ Pack a sketchpad and pencil to take a walking break and draw their favorite artwork.
- ◆ Pace yourself! You don't have to see the whole museum.
- ◆ Definitely visit Martin ArtQuest.
- ◆ Divide your visit into smaller blocks of time to have a snack, rest, and use the restrooms.
- ◆ Encourage children to look with their eyes, not their hands

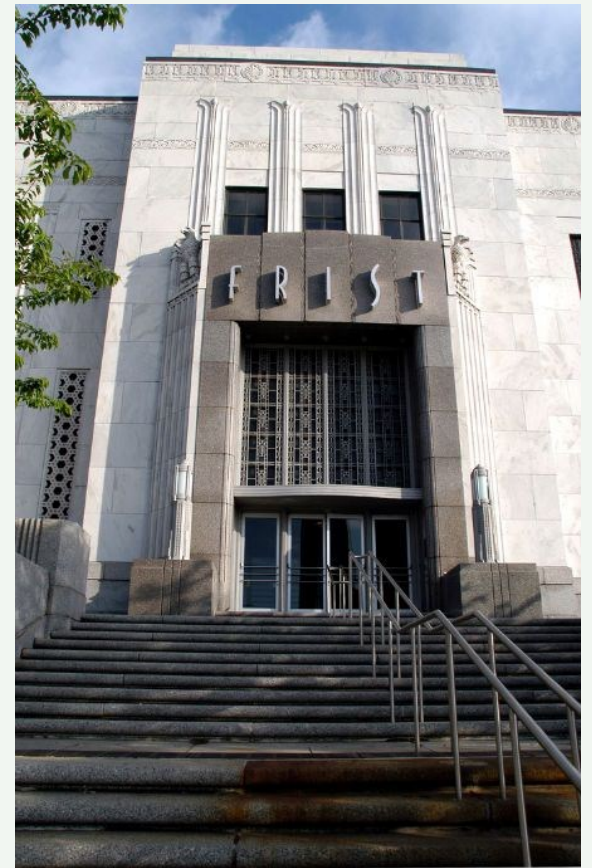
