

7 WAYS TO MAKE VIRTUAL MEETINGS MORE FUN

SCAVENGER HUNT

Have kids get up from their seats, find something interesting from around the room, and bring it back to the meeting. Can you find something with a unique texture? Two objects that are complementary colors? A piece of clothing with a pattern? The possibilities are endless!

FUNNY CO-HOST

Make your presentation more fun with an unexpected co-host. Allow a furry friend to make a quick appearance. At the elementary level, create a homemade puppet for comic relief.

COSTUME PARTY

Allow kids to dress up before the meeting. The theme could be art history (think van Gogh's bandaged ear or The Scream) or keep it simple with silly hats, glasses, or bright clothing.

CHANGE LOCATIONS

Hold your meeting from a different room in your house each day.

SKETCHBOOK SHARE

Have students share work from specific prompts or work of which they are extra proud.

SHOW AND TELL

Have younger students share something fun or something that's important to them. Have older students bring something to the meeting that has a good design or aesthetic appeal.

CRITIQUE

Recreate classroom critiques online by having students share what they've been working on. Alternately, do something fun with contemporary or historical art, like ranking famous artists or artworks or making other fun comparisons.
